**The Outlaws** were born in the blue-collar part port city of Tampa, Florida in the early 1970's. Following in the footsteps of such great bands as The Allman Brothers and The Eagles, The Outlaws developed their own high-powered, guitar-driven, country-rock, complete with exciting self-penned music and stellar three-part harmony. Today, the Outlaws are at the threshold of a new era. Along with original singer/songwriter/guitarist Henry Paul and drummer/songwriter Monte Yoho, the Outlaws feature Chris Anderson, Billy Crain, Randy Threet, and Jon Coleman.

**Shiny Toy Guns'** music flaunts a sleek, '80s-influenced combination of synth-pop and electro-clash. On November 2008, the band released their sophomore album Season of Poison, the follow up to their critically acclaimed Grammy nominated debut record We Are Pilots, which was released in 2006. "Ricochet" the debut single off of Season Of Poison hit #17 in the Modern Rock Tracks chart, the highest the band has ever reached in the charts.

**MUTEMATH** has built a reputation as a dynamic live band, wowing crowds on festivals with their no-holds barred shows. As Spin put it in the magazine's four-star review of the band's hook-laden self-titled major label debut: "It's hard to capture on record how ecstatic the band's sweaty live shows feel." Alternative Press Magazine recently named MUTEMATH as the "#1 Band You Need To See Live Before You Die," on their list of their 22 favorite performing bands. Fans are getting their first impression of the new MUTEMATH music, as the band's new song "Spotlight" is featured on the soundtrack to the hit movie "Twilight."
